**BASSETERRE, St.Kitts (Monday 4th July 2022)**- Among those who took part in a recent protest march organized by the St.Kitts-Nevis Labour Party (SKNLP) dubbed 'Freedom March' were three well-known public figures namely political/social commentator and businessman Carlton 'Licky Bud' Dupont, Pastor Cyprian Williams and health care worker and political/social commentator Carl Brown.

Independence Square Street, Bay Road and Fort Street.

This media house spoke with the three public figures. Here is what they had to say.

**Carlton Dupont**- “Here is what they had to say I am adamant that Timothy cannot be CCM, Labour and PAM, and de problem ah got with Timothy is that he all for himself and his family and I cannot stay in this country and look at Timothy bring the country into disrepute. The Governor General disappoint me; he made a very poor judgement in his decision and he didn’t make a just decision. Had made a just decision, we wouldn’t be where we are today. Praise God, the Labour supporter impress me today; they came out in large numbers and I know for sure Timothy can’t beat us. My outfit is to represent PAM. I don’t know why PAM didn’t come but I’m not responsible for that. I am a PAM/CCM and I believe PAM and CCM going win de elections but it doesn’t matter who win...once Timothy doesn’t win.”

**Pastor Cyprian Williams (New Birth Gospel Tabernacle)**- “Well, today is a national effort. I think Right now I think everyone can say that the country needs prayer. We are praying for peaceful

elections and that the Prime Minister will call elections as quickly as possible because the country needs to settle down and we’re praying for a peaceful outcome that whatever the will of the Lord will be will be and so that’s why I’ve joined with the citizens to be a part of this march today and we continue to pray. This is the seventh month and seven is the number of completion.”

**Carl Brown (Joseph N. France General Hospital worker)**- “I am marching for the health sector in St.Kitts and Nevis. We want our honourarium. I had to put on 10 and 12 suits space suits at night time to carry up these critical COVID patients and the health sector of St.Kitts and Nevis want they honourarium. Wendy Phipps did not touch a patient and she get \$27000. I want my honourarium. The nurses, doctors, maids, orderlies and staff; the entire sector of the health service want their honourarium. Abdias Samuel didn’t touch a patient and he get honourarium; I want my honourarium! All the other people who came on TV tell us so much lies; they get their honourarium. I am marching for the health sector for all of us to get our honourarium! We want our honourarium. I think marches like these are very

good in sending a message. The other people are marching for other reasons but I am representing all of the health

sector in St.Kitts and Nevis.”

Meanwhile, SKNLP Leader Dr. Terrance Drew, in addressing the crowd after the march, said in part: “Patriots of St.Kitts and Nevis! Today has been a mark in the history of St.Kitts and Nevis .Today we do not march only as Labour, we do not march only as PAM or CCM or PLP or NRP whether we are associated with any political party but today we march as a people of St. Kitts and Nevis and we are saying that we are not going to accept any action to undermine our democracy here in our country. Blood has been shed, lives have been lost for us to come to this point where we can enjoy freedom in St.Kitts and Nevis, and so I want to say to Timothy Harris that we will not accept your action to oppress our people anymore! Time for that has ended and the people have spoken back (through) democracy...”

# Dr. Drew Says PAP, Peace Programme Will Not End under SKNLP Government

**BASSETERRE, St.Kitts (Wednesday 6th July 2022)** - Under a St.Kitts-Nevis Labour Party (SKNLP)-led government, the current Poverty Alleviation Programme (PAP) will not end but will be improved upon which includes increasing monetary support according to the needs of households as well as providing other means and opportunities for wealth creation and empowerment.

So explained SKNLP Leader Dr. Terrance Drew when he appeared on 'Let's Get Real' Facebook talk show hosted by Maurice 'EK' Flanders on Tuesday 5th July 2022 as he expressed in shutting down rumours that "you will get the necessary funding to lift you out of poverty but we will not just give you the funding alone..."

"I want to say to the people of St.Kitts and Nevis that the St.Kitts-Nevis Labour Party will not end the intention of what the PAP is. That is not going to happen. We had a programme called the MEND [Mold Empower Nurture Direct] and we are going to challenge the PLP [People's Labour Party led by Prime Minister Dr. Timothy Harris] who has suggested that we want to end PAP. Tell them that we started the PAP but we didn't call it a poverty programme...and now we're saying we're going to mend the PAP..."

According to Dr. Drew: "[MEND] It's really a programme to help to empower people and lift them up and set them on a path so that they can really start to create wealth and the type of future that they need. We are going to present this to the people. We started the pilot programme that was supposed to become nationalized but when the government changed, what they did was instead of looking at the families and seeing what they require, they just said let's give them \$500, and so there are families getting \$500 but still living in poverty so that is not alleviating

poverty. That family might require a \$1000 to lift out of poverty, that family might require \$1500 to lift out of poverty, that family might require sending the child to a private class because they need that extra help, that family might require getting a laptop and internet service so that they children themselves can get a proper education in the next generation lift that family out. That family might require a mother who can sew well and might a sewing machine [and] some cloth and so on to bring in some extra money if she is given that necessary support and funding for a micro business."

As understood, said there would be requirements of the MEND programme to make sure children go to school at least 80% of the time and that a social worker will be working with them.

Dr. Drew stated that for the families and household "We'll help them to live above the poverty line and create opportunities for them so that one day they would be in a position to continue on and would not need the assistance of a government for all of their lives."

The SKNLP Leader, who was raised by a single grandmother and partly a single mom pointed out that: "I understand what families need from my own experience and own upbringing and if we do a programme like this, we can start to lift our people out of poverty and get them on a path of wealth creation so that by the time you reach the next generation or even in this present generation, they are creating wealth and they can create wealth which of course can improve the standing of their family, help them to save some money and look forward [to betterment]..."

He pointed out that attached to the MEND programme would be housing opportunities for single mothers.

According to the SKNLP Leader: "We will be looking...to ensure that the economy doesn't just look good on paper because we have surplus after surplus. We want to ensure that the economy is working for people, putting money in people's pockets and ensuring that people have good places to live, that they have healthcare for their children, they have energy, they have water so that they can live a life that is of course that they will be please with and the opportunity to be industrious and they should be industrious to create wealth for themselves with the opportunities being provided."

Similarly, the SKNLP continues to rubbish rumours that the Peace Programme will end under their administration, and has publicly spoken about the importance of providing opportunities to empower individuals also.

# PLP Takes Claims For Start of New BHS Construction Ahead of General Elections

**BASSETERRE, St.Kitts (Wednesday 6th July 2022)**- The Harris-led People’s Labour Party (PLP) via a recent social media post via Facebook informed that work has begun on the construction of the new Basseterre High School, which is fresh public debate topic in the lead up to the upcoming General Elections.

“The PLP is delivering a secure future for our children by fulfilling our commitment to build the Basseterre High School” was a caption posted on 50-second video highlight showing a bulldozer clearing the grassy area within the Basseterre Valley Aquifer region as posted on Monday 4th July 2022.

Speaking at a Cabinet Press Conference held Wednesday 29th June 2022, Prime Minister Dr. Timothy Harris claimed “there is no competition” between building the prison and the new BHS.

He bashed his fired colleagues former deputy Prime Minister and Education Minister and Jonel Powell, former Education of the People’s Action Movement (PAM) for failing to deliver a new school while praising the now Acting Education Minister Vincent Byron (the Attorney General) for getting the project going.

“Over the last seven years, we have budgeted 81.5 million dollars to get the Basseterre High School started. Again inefficiencies. We have had three ministers of education to be clear. Shawn Richard...he didn’t get it do, Jonel Powell...he didn’t get it do and we now have the honourable Vincent Byron working with the Minister of Public Infrastructure and in less than two months, we are moving ahead .Laziness not a lack of funds. \$81.5 million made available and that is more than you could spend...over the last seven years, and those who were charged with responsibility for delivery did not deliver

According to PM Harris: “It has taken the third minister of Education who is committed and an educator, committed to education and the Basseterre High School with its rich history to get this project going.”

Dr. Harris commended the new Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Infrastructure Eugene Hamilton and the AG “for getting done what couldn’t get be done in seven years.”

He continued: “That is what this has exposed for us so again drilling not a problem; money in the budget...just spend the money, get on with the work, get on with the job and that is why now we can get that project going without any coming back to the cabinet to get approval for extra funds because the money is there. So again it’s just silliness because we’re in the middle of the ‘silly season’ but these guys should know and really should do

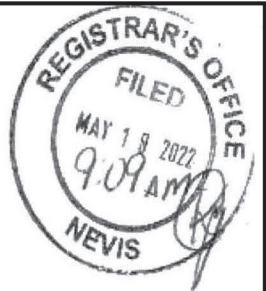

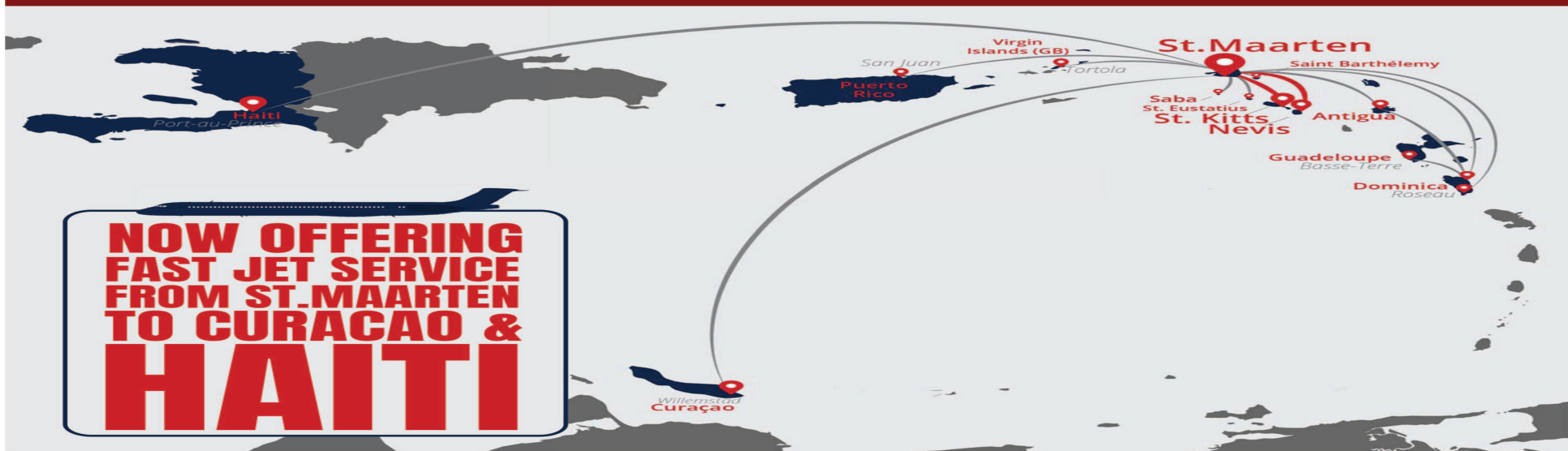

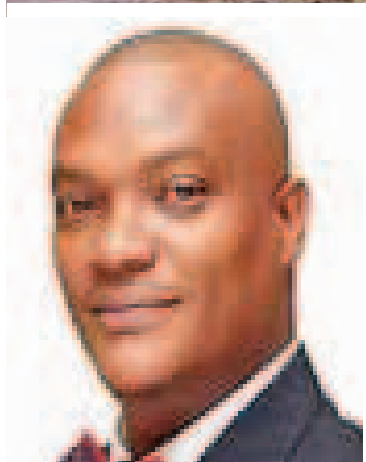

# Taiwan Touts New Air Force Advanced Training Jet's Abilities

**TAITUNG, Taiwan, 6 July (Reuters)** - Taiwan's air force showed off its new locally designed and made jet trainer on Wednesday, touting the more advanced, combat-capable abilities of the aircraft that will re-place aging and accident-prone existing equipment.

Taiwan's armed forces are mostly equipped by The United States, but President Tsai Ing-wen has made development of an advanced home-grown defence industry a priority, especially as China, which claims the island as its own, steps up military modernisation efforts and drills near Taiwan.

The new AT-5 Brave Eagle, made by state-owned Aerospace Industrial Development Corporation (AIDC) (2634.TW)1 with a budget of T\$68.6 billion (\$2.3 billion), had its first test flight in 2020.

It is Taiwan's first jet made domestically since the F-CK-1 Ching-kuo Indigenous Defence Fighter, or IDF, rolled out more than three decades ago, and the two jets look similar and have similar capabilities.

Three Brave Eagle's roared into the air at the Chihhang air base in Taitung, on Taiwan's east coast, in a show of its prowess in front of reporters.

Flight training officer Chang Chong-hao said the Brave Eagle was suitable for both air-to-air and air-to-ground combat training purposes, and can land and take off using a shorter amount of runway.

# Taiwan Navy's Yushan Landing Platform Dock Sails Out To Sea

**TAIPEI (Taiwan News)** - The Navy's first indigenous landing platform dock, the Yushan, sailed out to sea on Wednesday 6 July.

The landing dock was an example of Taiwan's policy to manufacture as many weapons systems inside the country as possible. It was built by CSBC Corporation, Taiwan and launched in April 2021.

According to The China Times, tests in May revealed leaks, but those were repaired in time for its first journey at sea near Kaohsiung City on Wednesday.

CSC Corporation, Taiwan, supplied

a new type of steel resistant to low temperatures to manufacture the ship.

Once its seven phases of testing are completed, it will be handed over to the Navy, most likely in September, the report said.

The dock can transport 673 soldiers, as well as amphibious armored vehicles, Humvees, and helicopters. It also comes equipped with features protecting against electromagnetic pulses and radar detection, while surface-to-surface and surface-to-air missiles can also be fired from the ship.

"So it helps give the students more space to deal with some unforeseen situations."

The Brave Eagle trainer can be equipped with weapons, though that remains in the testing phase, and the plane is designed to have a support function in time of war.

"We're not involved in the armaments part, those tests are up to the manufacturer AIDC," said air force officer Huang Chun-yuan. "Our main mission at the moment is general conversion training and tandem flying."

Taiwan's air force plans on taking 66 units by 2026 to replace aging AT-3 and F-5 training aircraft, which have suffered a series of crashes in recent years.

An AT-3, a model that first flew in 1980, crashed in May, while three F-5s have crashed in the past year or so.

The F-5s first entered service in Taiwan in the 1970s, though are no longer front line combat aircraft.

# Boris Johnson Resigns As Prime Minister - Here's Who Could Replace Him

Most prime ministers would have resigned over any one of the scandals to engulf Boris Johnson's government. Johnson, never one for tradition or rules, rode out nearly every crisis - but the Chris Pincher affair was the final straw.

Led by Health Secretary Sajid Javid and Chancellor Rishi Sunak, over 50 members of Johnson's government resigned in a day and a half.

Johnson has now resigned as party leader, vowing to remain PM until a new leader is chosen.

Johnson was not a typical leader, and his successor will have a difficult job. They will need to strengthen the Conservative party before the next general election (which could come sooner rather than later). They will need to distance themselves from the more problematic aspects of Johnson's legacy, while steadying the ship and appealing to the electorate. Here are the likely runners and riders for this seemingly impossible task:

## Ben Wallace

While not perhaps as well known as some of the candidates, Defence Secretary Ben Wallace is considered a serious contender. He has been pivotal in the UK's response to Russia's invasion of Ukraine and was clear in the run-up to the Taliban takeover in Afghanistan that action was needed to evacuate UK citizens and others in danger. He did not resign from Johnson's cabinet, which might count against him, but he certainly looks like a strong candidate. Early polling suggests Wallace is the candidate to beat, but the campaign will test his early popularity.

## Penny Mordaunt

Minister of State for Trade Policy Penny Mordaunt is not necessarily a household name, but she is very respected within the Conservative party. Mordaunt was a short-lived but well-respected defence minister and recently Royal Navy reservist. She previously served as secretary of state for international development (before the department was merged with the Foreign Office). Like Wallace, Mordaunt stuck by Johnson over the last few days, but her popularity within the party might allow her to overcome that issue, particularly if she can play up her pro-Brexit credentials.

## Rishi Sunak

The former chancellor was considered the leader in waiting in the early stages of the pandemic. His early successes with the furlough scheme elevated his status

and profile, but his star faded fairly quickly. Questions over his wife's tax status and wealth generally made Sunak seem out of touch with voters. He was also, along with Johnson, fined by police over lockdown parties in Downing Street. While he remains a strong candidate, he might have wished that his opportunity to stand for leader had come sooner.

## Sajid Javid

Javid has the distinction of having resigned from a Johnson cabinet twice. His first resignation, from his role as chancellor just before the pandemic, was driven by his desire to appoint his own staff. He was invited back into cabinet after Matt Hancock's resignation. While considered by many within the party as a very capable MP, with a working-class background that would count in his favour, some worry Javid showed a lack of judgment in rejoining the Johnson cabinet.

## Nadhim Zahawi

Zahawi came to public prominence when he spearheaded the vaccine rollout. His time as education secretary has been viewed positively, but his move to the Treasury less than two days before telling Johnson to resign have made some question his motives. Perception that he allowed personal ambition to override his moral compass is likely to hurt Zahawi. He will need to answer for this when asked by the party and country.

## Liz Truss

Currently overseas on official business, the foreign secretary will undoubtedly be thankful not to have been caught up in the chaos of this week. But is she too absent? While considered by many a "safe pair of hands" she is not a dynamic candidate for leader, and it is doubtful whether she can become an electoral asset to the party.

If the Conservatives want a safe choice instead of another "exciting" leader to follow Johnson, Truss may have a shot.

## Dominic Raab

The deputy prime minister is another potential leader in waiting. He has occupied a number of cabinet roles, including secretary of state for Brexit, foreign secretary and now justice minister. While he certainly has a high-ranking position, he has had a number of missteps. As Brexit minister, he finished off the negotiations his predecessor David Davis began, then resigned because he couldn't accept the deal he helped to finalise. As foreign secretary, he was criticised for his lack of speed during the Taliban takeover of Afghanistan. That, coupled with his earlier comments calling British workers the "worst idlers in the world" before he joined the cabinet, make him a long shot for Downing Street.

## The rest of the pack

On the backbenches, there are expected to be at least three potential candidates - former Health Secretary Jeremy Hunt, prominent Brexiteer Steve Baker, and well-respected backbench MP Tom Tugendhat. For any backbencher wanting to catapult themselves into Downing Street, the ride is likely to be bumpy. A track record of success is usually needed. This is harder for a backbencher, either because they have never been in cabinet, or because they have left cabinet (usually after being asked to). These individuals have a long road ahead of them.

There will be others who may want to scope out their prospects with the party.

# Poor Physical And Mental Health Among Older Adults Linked To Childhood Abuse History

Older adults who were physically abused as children were significantly more likely to develop chronic pain and chronic physical illness in later life according to a newly-released study by University of Toronto researchers. They were also twice as likely to develop depression and anxiety disorders compared to those without this early trauma.

“Sadly, our findings suggest that the traumatic experience of childhood physical abuse can influence both physical and mental health many decades later. It also underlines the importance of assessing for adverse childhood experiences among patients of all ages, including older adults,” said Anna Buhmann, who began this research for her undergraduate thesis in the Bachelor of Arts and Science program at McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario, and is a research assistant at The Institute of Life Course & Aging at The University of Toronto.

The physical illnesses that developed included diabetes, cancer, migraines, arthritis, heart disease, diabetes, and chronic-obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

The links between childhood abuse and poor physical and mental health persisted even after accounting for income, education, smoking, binge drinking, and other causes of poor health.

“Health professionals serving older adults need to be aware that it is never too late to refer people for counseling. A promising intervention, cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT), has been tested and found effective at reducing post-traumatic stress disorder and depressive and anxiety symptoms among survivors of childhood abuse,” said co-author Professor Esme Fuller-Thomson, who supervised Buhmann’s thesis research. Fuller-Thomson is Director of the Institute of Life Course & Aging at the University of Toronto’s Factor-Inwentash Faculty of Social Work.

It was not possible for the cross-sectional study to determine the specific pathways through which experiencing physical abuse as a child affects an individual’s health later in life. Current studies suggest that childhood physical abuse effects several physiological changes, including the dysregulation of systems that regulate the response of the body to stress. Future prospective research investigating disruptions to these systems that are already linked to several physical and mental illnesses, such as abnormal levels of cortisol, may help to shed light on the experience of childhood abuse victims.

The data for this study were drawn from a representative sample of adults aged 60 and older in the Canadian province of British Columbia. It compared 409

Cabinet secretaries Priti Patel or even Jacob Rees-Mogg might test the water, but they are likely to find it cold.

The battle ahead will inevitably have its twists and turns, and it is almost impossible to predict the outcome. Many within the Conservative party, and perhaps the country, will be hoping for less exciting times than they have recently lived through.

# Rafael Nadal to have scan before Wimbledon semi-final

Rafael Nadal will have a scan on an abdominal injury before his Wimbledon semi-final after it almost forced him to retire from his last-eight match.

The Spaniard, who faces Nick Kyrgios on Friday, said he ignored calls from his dad and sister to quit as he struggled with his movement against Taylor Fritz.

Nadal had a medical timeout and somehow - even he said he did not know how - came from behind to win in five sets.

"[Retiring] is something that I hate to do," the 36-year-old said.

"So I just keep trying, and that's it."

He also had strapping on his abdomen during his previous match but said the pain had got worse during Wednesday's 3-6 7-5 3-6 7-5 7-6 (10-4) victory over American Fritz.

"It's obvious that today is nothing new. I had these feelings for a couple of days. Without a doubt, today was the worst day," he said.

"[There has] been an important increase of pain and limitation. Tomorrow I am going to have some more tests."

Nadal says he is well used to pain, and playing with problems, during a career in which he has won a men's record 22 Grand Slam singles titles.

Only last month, he won his 14th French Open title without being able to feel his left foot as it was anaesthetised because of a chronic condition.

But he will not jeopardise his health when deciding whether he can play Kyrgios on Friday to continue his bid for a calendar Grand Slam, having already won the Australian and French Open titles this year.

"[There is] something more important than winning Wimbledon, that is health," he said.

He went off court during the second set against Fritz, with the doctor giving him anti-inflammatories and painkillers and the physio trying to relax the muscles.

"It's difficult," he said. "Nothing can be fixed when you have a thing like this. That's it."

"I just wanted to give myself a chance. [It is] not easy to leave the tournament. Not easy to leave Wimbledon, even if the pain was hard."

Asked what he thought his chances were of playing on Friday, Nadal replied: "I don't know. Honestly, I can't give you a clear answer because if I gave you a clear answer and tomorrow another thing happens, I will be a liar."

# Virat Kohli Requests To Be Rested From West Indies T20Is:

Star batter Virat Kohli himself asked for rest from the entire series against the West Indies, including the five T20Is, according to sources in the BCCI. It is also understood that the T20 squad for the tour of West Indies will be announced on July 11, one day after the shortest format series against England concludes. "It was team management's decision to rest Kohli, Rishabh Pant, Hardik Pandya, Jasprit Bumrah for the ODI series along with skipper himself," a senior BCCI source in the know of things told PTI on conditions of anonymity.

The five-match T20 series starts on July 29 in Tarouba, Trinidad followed by couple of matches in St Kitts (Aug 1 and 2) and it concludes in Florida on August 6 and 7 respectively.

"However for the T20I series, all others are playing but Kohli has himself asked for a break. He has informed that he will be available for all series after the West Indies tour," the source informed.

It is understood that senior off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin will be recalled for the T20 series in the Caribbean and the USA leg.

"Ashwin is very much in the scheme of things and he will be playing the T20 series in the West Indies. Also Washington Sundar is still not fit to play and by the time he gets fit, he will be playing for Lancashire in County Championship and Royal London Cup," he added.

While Kohli will get his break as he has sought but his place in the national T20 squad for the next big international assignment (Asia Cup in Sri Lanka) will depend on his T20 form in the two games that he will play against England beginning on Thursday.

In between, India are expected to play a short T20 series in Zimbabwe and just like in Ireland, a second string team is supposed to travel to the African nation.

KL Rahul is expected to be fit before the Asia Cup but if he recovers in time for the Zimbabwe tour, he will be part of that short series.

"Obviously, the stars will be rested for the Zimbabwe series as it will be followed by Asia Cup in Sri Lanka, home series against Australia and the team then travels to Australia for the World Cup," the source said.

Deepak Chahar, who is recovering from a hamstring and back injury, is expected to be fit for Asia Cup starting August 27.

# West Indies "A" to face Bangladesh "A" in St Lucia in four-day "Tests" and 50-over matches

**Wednesday, 6 July 2022 - ST JOHN'S, Antigua** - Cricket West Indies (CWI) and the Bangladesh Cricket Board (BCB) today announced the match schedule for the West Indies Men's "A" Team series against Bangladesh Men's "A" Team in August. The series will be played at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Saint Lucia and will feature two four-day first-class matches and three 50-over matches from 4 to 20 August.

This will be the first West Indies Men's "A" Team series since 2020. The COVID-19 pandemic restricted opportunities and the resumption of West Indies Men's "A" team matches sees the return of a key development opportunity for players pushing for selection to the West Indies senior team and for emerging players to build their First-Class International experience.

Roland Holder, CWI's Senior Operations Manager said the series will provide exposure for a number of players and noted it was part of CWI's commitment to continually developing talent for the international level. He said: "We are pleased to have confirmed the itinerary for the Men's "A" Team series with the BCB and we are excited to host Bangladesh in the region again. This is a vital part of the development of our players in the pathway toward full international selection, and no doubt this upcoming series of matches in Saint Lucia will provide a platform for further exposure and progress."

He added that CWI and BCB are also in the planning stages for a reciprocal tour by West Indies "A" to Bangladesh in 2023.

BCB CEO Nizam Uddin Chowdhury said the "A" Series provides an excellent opportunity for players of both teams to prepare for international commitments. "The international schedule is getting busier by the season and therefore it is very important for the cricketers to keep themselves ready through good competitive cricket. We thank CWI for accommodating the A tour. The four-day 'Tests' and the One-Day matches will be invaluable experience for the players," he noted. "The BCB and CWI share a warm longstanding relationship and have worked tirelessly to make this tour happen. I hope we will see more reciprocal programmes between the two boards in the future."
